Our Challenge


For nearly 70 years, we have been blessed to provide an exceptional education in our original facilities. However, the oldest structures of our school, in particular the 1950's wing, needs our attention. Continued repairs and maintenance are extensive and very expensive due to deterioration and the age of the building. Renovating and expanding the existing facility has been considered, but is not cost effective. Therefore, it was decided to tear down and construct a new school wing that best facilitates inspired and engaged learning.



Our History

As the new millennium dawned, Holy Rosary parish leadership thoroughly inspected the state of the church and school buildings. Recognizing the limitations and inadequacy of the campus facilities to meet the demands of our faith community, parish leadership developed a master plan to resolve the identified issues. In Phase I of the master plan, a new parish center was completed in 2010 with great success.

The next step Phase II, replacing the oldest section of the school, was on hold for a few years due to the pandemic. Consequently, it was necessary to review the architect's original design to ensure up-to-date pricing and fiscally responsible planning. Diligent research by Hord Architects into these concerns led to a simplified redesign of the new building.



Our Plan

A two story building will replace the 1950's one story wing. The new building will consist of school offices, two learning centers, six classrooms, an infirmary, lavatories, print/storage area, and mechanical rooms. It will also feature a more identifiable and secure entryway to the school. Ease of access into the building and an improved ergonomic interior design will greatly benefit everyone, especially persons with physical difficulties.

The new wing will accommodate the growing programs within Holy Rosary School that meet the demands of students in our community. It will provide much needed space for The Learning Center (TLC) program. TLC serves students with language-based learning differences such as dyslexia. The program is a 4:1 learning environment with two classes per classroom. Since its inception in 2018, enrollment has increased from six students to 35.

Another specialized program we offer is The ANGEL Program, serving students living with autism. Students in this program will have the opportunity to engage with the most update-to-date technology and flourish in the space afforded by a new facility.

Our enrollment capacity will remain the same; however, we will gain more spacious and efficient classrooms. Additionally, new facilities will aid the effort to maintain our enrollment by appealing to both current and prospective school families. Most importantly, it will provide an environment better suited to learning for our students.

Strategic Advantages

There are many additional benefits to building new. First and foremost, it is a better long-term investment. Renovating the existing facilities would cost up to 75% or more of the cost of a new building. Second, the existing 1950s school wing is well beyond its anticipated life expectancy. Moreover, the proposed new building will have far greater longevity. Third, the new building will be more energy efficient, reducing operation costs. Fourth, starting with a fresh template affords us the opportunity to specifically design the new facility to meet our needs without the constraints of an existing floor plan. Fifth, it will enable us to more readily adapt to the periodic but necessary technological upgrades. Finally, building new allows for more greenspace and better use of the limited land we own.

Catholic Education and Formation have always been integral and essential ministries of Holy Rosary. This project is key to ensuring a Faith-based education for all students that fosters excellence in the spiritual, academic, physical, and social formation of students. It will positively impact the life of Holy Rosary Church and School as well as the East Memphis community for generations.

Summary

To achieve our objectives, Holy Rosary parish leadership has launched the Building Our Future Capital Campaign. The overall estimated financial need to accomplish all of these projects is \$7.5 million, which includes the parish portion to the Diocese of Memphis Campaign United In Faith. Our goal is to raise \$2.5 million or more from within the parish and school. Funds will also be sought from other sources outside of the parish. (See page 7).



How To Pledge Your Support

Holy Rosary Church & School seeks to raise \$2.5 million or more through this campaign. Additional funds will be sought from other sources outside of the parish. Every member of our parish and school community is integral to our success in reaching this goal and, therefore, each family is asked to consider making a pledge to the campaign to the best of their ability.

Each family is asked to consider a pledge of \$5,000 or more, payable over three years. Methods Of Pledging

Pledges via Cash or Check

Simply complete your pledge card by noting the amount of your pledge and down payment. Be sure to select your method of payment, i.e., monthly, quarterly, semi-annual or annual payments. Please make checks payable to **HRC Building Our Future**.

You will be sent payment reminders and a special payment envelope in accordance with the payment plan you choose. You may return the pledge card in the weekly collection, bring it to the parish office, or return it by mail.

Pledges Via Debit Or Credit Card

Please visit **www.holyrosarychurchmphs.org/donate/** to make your pledge via debit or credit card. In addition, please return your completed pledge card to the Development Office.

Gifts of Stock

You may use your own broker/agent or the parish's agent to transfer gifts of stock. If the stock has been held for one year or longer, you do not have to pay capital gains tax on the stock, and are allowed a tax deduction for the full value of the stock, provided that the stock is transferred to the parish before being liquidated. The stock is not required to have appreciated in value since you purchased it. If you are interested in a stock donation, please contact the Campaign Office or make a notation on the pledge card so we may provide you with the necessary information.

Gifts of Property, Life Insurance, Annuities, Wills or Bequests

There are different ways to support Holy Rosary Parish both today, and in the years to come via planned giving. Families or individuals can make gifts of real estate, personal property, automobiles, life insurance, estate bequests, annuities or charitable remainder trusts. For substantial gifts of property other than marketable securities, the IRS requires an appraisal. Please contact the Parish Office for more information*.

*Please confirm current tax law with your tax advisor or the IRS.



IRA Contributions

An IRA owner, age 70½ or over, can directly transfer tax-free up to \$100,000 per year to an eligible charity. This option can be used for distributions from IRAs, regardless of whether the owners itemize their deductions. Distributions from employer-sponsored retirement plans, including SIMPLE IRAs and simplified employee pension (SEP) plans, are not eligible*.

To qualify, the funds must be transferred directly by the IRA trustee to the eligible charity. Distributed amounts may be excluded from the IRA owner's income resulting in lower taxable income for the IRA owner*.
